Minutes from the Grant County Canvass
Spring Election
April 10, 2026

The Grant County Canvass for the April 7, 2026 election was held on Friday, April 10, 2026 in Lancaster, WI at the Administration Building in the first-floor conference room.

Members present: Chantel Hampton, Julie Durst, Karla Schwantes and Tonya White

All the totals were verified. The Federal/State Office Certification report was signed Friday, April 10, 2026 by all the canvassers and sent to the Wisconsin Election Commission at elections.canvass@wi.gov and a hard copy was sent by mail to the Wisconsin Election Commission.

Some incidents that were noted during the County Canvass were:

It was determined that if any write in ovals were marked but no name was written in those scattering would not count.

1. T. Bloomington did not put total number of voters on the tally sheet
2. T. Boscobel did not put total number of voters on the tally sheet
3. T. Cassville did not put total number of voters on the tally sheet
4. T. Harrison write in no name for Supreme Court and Court of Appeals/not valid scattering
5. T. Hickory Grove absentee list missing from canvass materials, didn't put total number of voters on the tally sheet
6. T. Jamestown absentee list missing from canvass materials
7. T. Liberty no write in tape so can't verify write ins, machine tape does not match any documentation for canvass
8. T. Lima didn't record the write-ins for supervisor on the tally sheet; tally sheet not fully filled out
9. T. Marion didn't put total number of voters on the tally sheet
10. T. Millville inspector statement has incorrect voter total
11. T. Mount Hope no total amount of voters on inspector statement
12. T. Mount Ida absentee list missing from canvass materials, no name for write ins
13. T. Paris absentee list missing from canvass materials
14. T. Platteville W2 absentees incorrect on inspector statement (Clerk notified us before canvass began)
15. T. Potosi inspector statement not complete
16. T. Smelser didn't put total number of voters on the tally sheet
17. T. South Lancaster didn't put total number of voters on the tally sheet
18. T. Watterstown didn't put total number of voters on the tally sheet

19. T. Woodman can't verify write in; absentee list missing from canvass materials, front page of poll book not filled out, machine tape not signed by poll workers, totals on tally sheet not added properly (didn't add machine totals and paper)

21. V. Blue River no total listed on the tally sheet
22. V. Cassville no name as write in
23. V. Mount Hope no total listed on the tally sheet
24. V. Muscoda only one write in is valid
25. V. Tennyson inspector statement incomplete
26. C. Platteville W1-4 no total listed on tally sheet for central count; W 7-8 no write in machine tape for central count

The Board of Canvass had planned to do machine audits on two randomly picked municipalities. Town of Little Grant and Town of Wyalusing. Both municipalities matched the machine tape.
