The Grant County Board approved ATV State Highway connecting routes are currently awaiting WisDOT traffic signing permits so installation can occur, which will effectively open these short sections of State Highway to ATV traffic.

REMINDER – It is currently illegal to operate ATV's on State Highways unless the roadway is signed/posted according to law.

The following State Highway routes are awaiting permits:

- USH 18 in the Town of Mt Ida, County K to County K for a distance of 0.5 miles.
- USH 61 in the Town of Liberty, County E to Circle Rd for a distance of 0.1 miles.
- USH 61 in the Town of Paris, Indian Creek Rd to Oak Rd for a distance of 0.1 miles.
- STH 133 in the Town of Waterloo, County N to County N for a distance of 0.5 miles.
- STH 133 in the Town of Watterstown, Old C to the 35 MPH speed zone in the Village of Blue River for a distance of 0.49 miles.
- STH 133 in the Town of Woodman, Woodman Lake Rd to Dutch Hill Rd for a distance of 0.36 miles.
- STH 133 in the Town of Cassville, Cadwell Rd to Far Nuf Rd for a distance of 0.49 miles.
- USH 61 in the Town of Boscobel and the Town of Marion, Wisconsin Ave to Old 61 Rd for a distance of 0.3 miles.
- STH 133 in the Town of Cassville from Jack Oak Rd to Cadwell Rd for a distance of 1.89 miles.
- USH 61 in the Town of Marion, Old 61 Rd to Peer Rd for a distance of 0.2 miles.
- STH 133 in the Town of Woodman, County C to County K for a distance of 1 mile.

The follow State Highway routes are signed and open for ATV traffic:

- ✓ STH 133 in the Village of Potosi, Brewery Hollow Rd to East River Lane for a distance of 0.7 miles.
